


# First use

Connect the headphone with the USB-C cable and a USB power adapter\* (\*not included in the delivery). Wait until the red indicator led turn blue.

#### **Bluetooth connection**

#### **Pairing**

Power on the BT-X65 headphone. It automatically starts the pairing mode.



After it prompts power on, the indicator LED flashes red and blue.

Start the Bluetooth scan function with your smartphone / tablet or any other Bluetooth enabled device.

Click on "MusicMan BT-X65" in the Bluetooth settings to pair your device with the headphone.

#### Reset pairing

Unpair the headphone in BT settings of your smartphone / tablet. It can be connected to another device now.

#### **Auto reconnection**

The BT-X65 headphone will reconnect to the last paired BT-device automatically if its reachable. To change the paired connection to another device, unpair the last connected device.

#### **Functions**

#### Power On/Off

Press and hold the power button for about 3 seconds to turn the headphone on or off.

### Play/Pause music

Press the power button to play/pause the music.

## Next song/Last song

Press and hold volume up/down for next or return to the previous song.

#### **Answer phone calls**

Incoming calls can be answered by single press the power button during the ringing.

#### Hang up calls

Phone calls can be cancelled by single press the power button.

## Reject calls (hold 2 sec.)

To reject calls, hold the power button for 2 seconds.

#### **AUX-In**

This headphone can be used by connect an AUX cable to a device and the AUX-In port. Use a 3.5mm jack cable to connect. Note: Connect to device without power on the headphone.

# **Troubleshooting**

If you cannot connect the headphone to your phone, do as follows:

Ensure that the headphone is charged and in on state. Ensure that the Bluetooth feature is activated on your device. Check that the headphone is within 10m of your phone and that there are no obstructions between the headphone and the phone, such as walls or other electronic devices. Try to use an AUX-In adapter cable to connect it wired. The BT-X65 powers off or does not turn on again could be either a low battery or a problem with the power supply. Charge the BT-X65 and check the battery status of the charging LED. (We suggest charging the BT-X65 all 2–3 month if it is not used for a long time.)

#### **Notes**

- ●Noises are heard from the BT-X65 could be a poor Bluetooth signal. To avoid noise, stay within the Bluetooth range of ~10m.
- •While the headphone is charging, no music can be played. This
- Avoid prolonged exposure to excessive volume that may cause noise-induced hearing impairment. ●Turn the volume down before putting on your headphones, then adjust it to the right volume. ●Do not use headphones while driving or riding your bike. ●Stay away from sharp edges, uneven surfaces, metal parts, and anything that could damage the headphones. ●Do not modify, repair or remove headphones without professional guidance. ●Do not use corrosive or volatile liquid to clean the earphone. ●Do not use headphones in dangerous environments.

# **Warnings**

- Only charge the BT-X65 charging box through the DC 5V USB-C port by using the provided USB-C charging cable. Use a power charging adapter up to DC 5V/1A. Do not charge the BT-X65 with more power!
- If the BT-X65 fails to link to your mobile device or if it fails to play music after being connected, the user shall check if your mobile device supports A2DP / AVRCP.
- Do not disassemble the BT-X65, it may result in short-circuit or damage.
- Battery warning: Improper use of the battery may cause fire or chemical burns. The battery may explode in case of damage. The battery can only be charged using an adapter especially provided for this product.
- Do not drop or shake the BT-X65, it may break internal circuit boards or mechanics.
- Keep the BT-X65 in dry and ventilated environment. Avoid high humidity and high temperature. Also, batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat or direct sunlight.
- This BT-X65 is not water-resistant; keep it away from moisture.
- Keep the BT-X65 away from little children.
