Safety instructions

- Read these operating instructions carefully before using the appliance for the first time.
- Above all, follow the safety instructions!
- The appliance may only be operated as described in these operating instructions.

- If you ever pass the appliance on to someone else, please include these operating instructions. The operating instructions are an integral part of the product.
- •If the mains connection cable of this product is damaged, it must be be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified service centre or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid hazards.



DANGER of electric shock due to moisture!

- The appliance must never be operated in the vicinity of a bathtub, shower, filled washbasin or similar.
- The base unit, the connecting cable and the mains plug must not be immersed in water or other liquids.
- Protect the base unit from moisture, dripping and splashing water.
- If liquid gets into the item, disconnect the mains plug immediately. Have the appliance checked before using it again.
- Do not operate the appliance with wet hands.
- If the appliance has fallen into water, unplug it immediately. Only then remove the appliance from electric shock due to moisture.

Danger of electric shock!

- Only insert the mains plug into a socket outlet at when the appliance is fully assembled.
- Only connect the mains plug to a properly installed, easily accessible socket outlet with protective contacts whose voltage corresponds to the information on the rating plate. The socket outlet must remain easily accessible after connection.
- Make sure that the connecting lead cannot be damaged by sharp edges or hot spots. Do not wrap the connecting lead around the device.

- The appliance is not completely disconnected from the mains even after it has been switched off. To do this, you must pull out the mains plua.
- Make sure that the connecting lead never becomes a tripping hazard or that someone can get caught in it or step on it.
- Keep the connecting cable away from hot surfaces (e.g. hotplates).
- When using the appliance, make sure that the connecting cable is not pinched or crushed.
- To remove the mains plug from the socket, always pull on the plug, never on the cable.

- if a fault occurs
- if you are not using the Device
- before you clean the Divice
- during thunderstorms
- Do not use the appliance if there is visible damage to the appliance or the connecting cable.
- •To avoid danger, do not make any changes to the appliance.

- ●If there is something wrong with the heater, please turn off the machine and put off the plug immediately and send to service agent.

 •Warning: In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the heater.

- The heater must not be located immediately below a socket-outlet.
- ●There is slight sound when turned on or off, which is normal due to the material
- expanding when heated and contract when cooled, please do not be worried.

 The used heating element treated by a special way, it has a long using life, please do not use any other heating element instead of it.
- This appliance only for household use.
- •WARNING: Do not use this heater in small rooms when they are occupied by persons not capable of leaving the room on their own, unless constant supervision is provided.
- Do not use this heater if it has been dropped.
- •Do not use if there are visible signs of damage to the heater.
- Use this heater on a horizontal and stable surface.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, keep textiles, curtains, or any other flammable material a minimum distance of 1 m from the air outlet.



Now you can set a Temperature by pressing "fthe set Temprature higher than Room Temperature the ceramic heater starts heating."

Or you can press "(**)" one time to start with 1st heating level (1400W) Display show "** ** " or 2 times for 2nd heating level (2000W), Display show "** ** ** "

To start or stop "decorative fireplace press "(a)" You can adjust the timer from 0-8hours by pressing this button "(1)" again.

Swing: to start or stop swing function press "

To Set a temperature you can press "

the range can be adjusted from 18-45°C



- "Set Temperature 18-45°C in combination with +/- button



Replacement of the remote-control battery

Before using the remote control, please remove the plastic insulation sheet of the remote control follow the arrow for use; (see Figure 1)

If the battery in the remote control needs to be replaced, refer to Figure 2, the first step is to push out the lock to the arrow 2, the second step is to pull out the cover to the direction of the arrow 3, you can replace the battery, after replacing the battery, push the cover into the remote control in the opposite direction of the arrow 3, until the arrow 2 locks;

The battery used is button lithium battery (CR2025).
