Safety instructions

 Read these operating instructions carefully before using the appliance for the first time.

- The appliance may only be operated as described in these operating instructions.
- Keep these operating instructions in a safe place.
- If you ever pass the appliance on to someone else, please include these operating instructions. The operating instructions are an integral part of the product.

Safety rules for rechargeable batteries

The product uses rechargeable batteries and can go wherever you need them. But ALL batteries can EXPLODE, CATCH FIRE, and CAUSE BURNS if disassembled, punctured, cut, crushed, short-circuited, incinerated, or exposed to water, fire, or high temperatures, so you must handle them with care.

To use the rechargeable batteries safely, follow these guidelines:

- ALWAYS store spare batteries in a cool, dry, ventilated area.
- ALWAYS make sure that the battery compartment is clean and free of any debris before inserting new batteries.
- ALWAYS make sure the battery contacts are aligned.
- ALWAYS keep all batteries away from children.
- ALWAYS follow local waste and recycling laws when throwing used batteries away.
- ALWAYS use the product to charge the rechargeable batteries.
- NEVER place the rechargeable batteries in a pocket, purse, or other receptacle, especially those containing metal objects.
- NEVER store the rechargeable batteries with hazardous or combustible materials.

- NEVER let the rechargeable battery or battery compartment get wet before, during, or after installation. (Remember, your product itself is weatherproof, but its interior battery compartment and batteries aren't.)

Danger of electric shock!

- Only insert the mains plug into a socket outlet at when the appliance is fully assembled.

voltage corresponds to the information on the rating plate. The socket outlet must remain easily accessible after connection.

- Make sure that the connecting lead cannot be damaged by sharp edges or hot spots. Do not wrap the connecting lead around the device.


How to use:

Before using the item for the first time charge the battery with the original charger for at least 2 hours. The first charging could take up to 6 hours, pls check the charging indicator, if the battery is fully charged the LED turns to green. Never store your device with a drained battery. It will shorten the life of your battery. For optimal battery life, it is best to store the device after recharging it.

Filling the spray bottle


Open the spray bottle by turning the neck of the bottle. Fill in clean water and lock the bottle. The bottle is very easy to be blocked by dirt, so please be careful. Do not use any cleaning agents other than those recommended by the manufacturer.


Locking the Head



Position the head at a slight angle, as shown in Figure A. Please fully respect the direction indicated in Figure A. Put the head on the body and then make a slight rotation in the opposite direction as showed in Figure B to lock the head Figure C.

Assembling and replacing the Cleaning Pads





Place the pad holder (2) in front of you Figure 1, and then carefully apply the cleaning pad over the velcro surface (1) Figure 1. The metallic scrubbers on the cleaning pads should be exposed.

Finally press the entire wipe to the support surface.

The wipes should be replaced regularly. The frequency will depend on your use and the quantity

of windows that are cleaned with this unit.

To change or remove the wipe, simply tear the wipe off the velcro surface. Figure 2 These wipes are machine washable at 40 $^{\circ}$ C.

Do not iron or bleach the cleaning pads and not to put the cleaning pads in the dryer. Do not use fabric softener. When washing the wipe with other textiles, not to mix with thin or fragile textiles such as lace or silk. The scrubbing surface of the cleaning cloth is abrasive and could damage these fragile textiles. It is strongly suggested to use LIFENAXX original wipes as other wipes may not provide the desired results.


Efficiency

Due to non-use of detergent products which usually have oil-based compound or animal fat, you will leave no more "new" fat on your smooth surfaces (you can sometimes see grease residues when the sun shines through windows). The LIFENAXX Window Cleaner will reduce your cleaning frequency because it effectively removes all grease from your windows thereby preventing new residues from sticking to your window surfaces as often.

Precautions

When using this device on sensitive surfaces such as plastic or high gross paints always test with your wipe on a hidden area in order not to damage the appearance of your surface. We are not responsible for any damaged surfaces.

Cleaning









Once you have positioned the cloth on the appliance, you can simply spray some water on the window with your spray bottle Figure 3. Do not spray too much water on the window, otherwise it will drip onto the floor. Move the window cleaner up and down as shown in figure (4) to loosen the dirt. Pay particular attention to the edges of the window. Once the dirt has been loosened, turn the window cleaner over (Figure 5) and start the suction function using the on/off switch (5). Place the window vacuum cleaner in a corner of the window and pull it down to the end of the window as shown in Figure 5.

Do not press hard against the window while vacuuming, only press hard enough so that the silicone lip rests against the window. Start in a corner and vacuum the water from the window. Be neither too slow nor too fast. The right speed from top to bottom (1 metre in 1-2 seconds) leads to the best result.

The Multi Micro suction technology does the rest of the work. The window vacuum cleaner cannot work against the force of gravity, if you are vacuuming horizontal surfaces you must hold the appliance vertically after each suction so that the dirty water can run into the tank.

When you have finished cleaning the windows or there is a certain amount of dirty water in the tank, empty it via the drain opening as shown in Figure 6.
