**Note:** The remote does not come with AAA batteries. Please ensure you install two new batteries before use. Gently remove the back cover of the battery compartment and insert the new batteries, following the polarity markings inside the compartment.

## Quick Start

### Installation Options:



### Note:

Whichever installation option you select, please make sure:

→ To go to *Homepage > Settings > Projection* to select the corresponding

projection mode, so the images can be projected correctly.

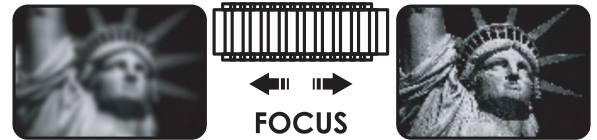
→Mounting Screw: 1/4"(not included)

### Power On/Off:

- Take off the lens cover
- Connect the power adapter cable to an outlet
- Press the power button once to turn on the projector
- Press the power button twice to turn off the projector

### Manual Focus

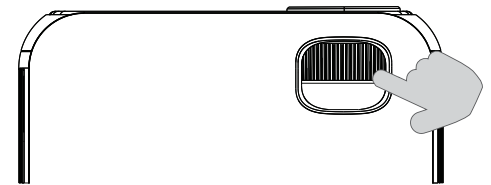
Turn the focus wheel (1) until the blurry image becomes clear.



### Keystone Correction

Upon powering on the projector, it will automatically correct any keystone distortion within a range of vertical/horizontal  $\pm 45^\circ$ . A

side projection of 20 degrees has virtually no impact on the resolution, while between 20 and 45 degrees, there may be a slight impact.



### Manual Keystone Correction

Go to *Homepage* > *Settings* > *Keystone* > *Four Points Correction* to manually correct the image shape by four points.

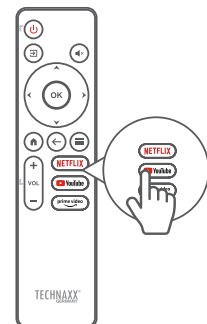
### Image Scaling

Go to *Homepage* > *Settings* > *Zoom* to reduce or enlarge the image size between 50% and 100%.

### Play Content

Go to the Homepage or select your preferred platform via the shortcuts on the remote, then log in to your account to play the corresponding content.

**Note:** A streaming subscription could be required.



### Projector connection and input source

Connect your device to the projector correctly, then select the right input source:

#### USB-Connection

To play files stored on a USB disk, insert the disk into the projector. Then go to *Homepage* > *Inputs* and select *USB* to locate and play the desired file.

#### HDMI-Connection

To connect a device with a HDMI output port to the projector, use a HDMI cable to connect it to the projector's HDMI input port (16). Then go to *Homepage* > *Inputs* and select *HDMI*.

## Wired Speaker and Headphone Connection

Connect an AUX-Plug to the Audio Output (15) to hear wired Sound from the projector.

## Wi-Fi Connection

To connect the projector with the Wi-Fi of your home, go to *Homepage > Setting > Network*. If necessary, type in your Wi-Fi password to connect successfully.

## Screen Mirroring

Connect both the projector and your mobile device to the same Wi-Fi network or directly connect the projector to your mobile device's hotspot.

**Note:** If you are using the mobile device's hotspot, the content will be mirrored using cellular data. Due to copyright restrictions, content from certain apps or streaming services cannot be wirelessly mirrored or cast.

### For Android Systems:

To enable this feature, ensure your Android device supports Multi-Screen, Smart View, or Wireless Display. The name may vary depending on your Android device.

→ Go to the Wi-Fi settings on your Android device and turn on Wi-Fi.

→ Navigate to the *Homepage > My Apps > Screencast* to access the screen mirroring interface.

→ Enable the Multi-Screen, Smart View, or Wireless Display function on your Android device and search for the projector.

→ Select "TX-332" from the list. Once the connection is established, the content from your Android device will be mirrored onto the projection screen or wall.

### For iOS Systems:

→ Go to *Homepage > My Apps > APP Assistant*. Then, select ScreenShare and press OK on the remote to download and install the ScreenShare app.

**Note:** You will need to download the ScreenShare app for the initial setup. After that, you can skip this step. After downloading the ScreenShare app, please restart the projector to ensure it functions properly.

→ Return to the My Apps page and launch the ScreenShare app to open the following screen.

→ Access the Control Center on your iOS device, then tap Screen Mirroring or AirPlay to search for the projector.


→ Select "TX-332" from the list. Once the connection is established, the content from your iOS device will be mirrored onto the projection screen or wall.

## Home Share

→ Connect both the projector and your mobile device to the same Wi-Fi network.

→ Go to the *Homepage > My Apps*, then select **HomeShare** to open the page. Make sure the toggle is switched to **On**.

→ Open a video player app on your mobile device and select a video to play.

→ Press  to search for the projector and select "TX-332" to connect. The content on your device will be cast to the screen.

## **BT-Speaker**

In addition to the wired 3.5mm audio output port, you can also connect Bluetooth speakers or Bluetooth headphones to the projector via Bluetooth.

→ Power on your Bluetooth device and make it ready for pairing.

→ Go to *Homepage > Settings > Bluetooth* to scan for available devices.

→ Select your device and pair it with the projector.

**Note:** Bluetooth connections may cause audio delay due to signal interference, especially when using wireless screen mirroring with Wi-Fi and Bluetooth simultaneously.

Use a HDMI connection and Bluetooth simultaneously instead of wireless screen mirroring. Or, use a wired speaker for audio.

## **Settings**

### **Setup**

- Set the projector's language.
- Adjust the date and time settings.
- Enable the screensaver to activate after a period of inactivity.
- Set the screen turn-off timer.
- Set the screen to automatically turn off after a period of inactivity.
- Update the software as needed.
- Restore the projector to factory settings.

### **Picture Mode**

Select the picture mode and adjust image settings such as color temperature, contrast, and more.

### **Audio**

Choose your preferred sound style (e.g., vivid, movie).

Select the correct digital output mode.

### **Bluetooth**

Connect the projector to external Bluetooth speakers and headphones.

### **Network**

Connect the projector to a working Wi-Fi network.

### **Projection**

Select the appropriate projection mode for accurate image display.

### **Keystone**

- Enable automatic keystone correction when the projector is powered on. **Note:** Vertical keystone correction is supported only.
- Manually correct the keystone.



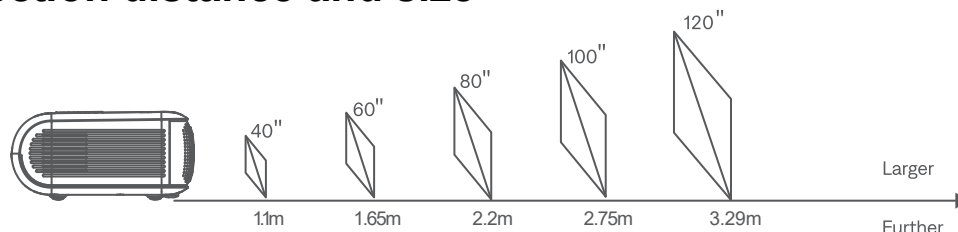

## Projection distance and size



- The ideal projection distance depends on the content being projected. Adjust the distance between the projector and the wall/screen as needed.
- A darker environment will enhance the clarity of the projected images.
- For the best image quality, we recommend a projection size of 80 to 100 inches.

## Apps

You can't download apps from the App Store. To download more apps as below mentioned, go to *Homepage > My Apps > APP Assistant*. Here you can find all apps to install.

After downloading the app, go back to the homepage, scroll down to find the app, and open it to access the content.

## Troubleshooting

**Can I use Netflix directly on the projector?** Yes, you can. The projector comes with pre-installed, officially licensed apps for Netflix, YouTube, and Prime Video. This allows you to easily watch your favorite videos directly on the projector without any hassle.

**Why can't I mirror or cast content from some Apps?** Due to copyright restrictions from services like Hulu, Disney+, and others, content from these platforms cannot be mirrored or cast. To view copyrighted content, please use a laptop, Fire TV Stick, Roku Stick, or Chromecast and connect it to the projector.

### **Why there is no sound output from projector speaker or wireless / wired speaker?**

- Due to copyright restrictions with Dolby, this projector does not support Dolby audio decoding. Dolby audio files can be played through devices connected via HDMI.
- Sound type should be switched to stereo in App sound settings.

### **Why isn't the remote control working?**

- Ensure the remote is pointing directly at the IR receiver.
- Make sure the remote has two new AAA batteries installed.
- Avoid mixing new and old batteries in the remote, as this can cause insufficient power and operational issues.

**Can I sideload Android apps onto the projector?** Unfortunately, sideloading Android apps onto the projector is not supported.

### **Auto Focus/Auto Keystone isn't working**

- Try restoring the projector to its factory settings and see if the issue persists. Note: All settings will be deleted during factory reset.

### **The picture isn't bright enough**

- For the best viewing experience, we recommend using the projector in a dark environment. The darker the room, the better the image quality.

### **The image is blurry**

- Adjust the focus/keystone settings.
- Ensure the projector and screen/wall are at the correct distance for optimal clarity.

### **Upside-down image**

- Go to *Home > Settings > Projection* to flip the projection image.

### **Factory reset**

- Go to *Home > Settings > Setup > Reset Default* to restore the projector to its default settings.

## **Hints**

● Make sure you lay the cable in a way that the danger of stumbling is avoided. ● Never hold or carry the device by the power cable. ● Do not clamp or damage the power cable. ● Ensure that the power adapter do not come into contact with water, steam or other liquids. ● You have to check the complete construction at regular intervals for functionality, tightness and damage to prevent the defect of the device. ● Install the product due to this user manual and operate or maintain it in accordance with the manufacturers operating instructions. ● Only use the product for purposes due to its intended function & only for household use. ● Do not damage the product.
