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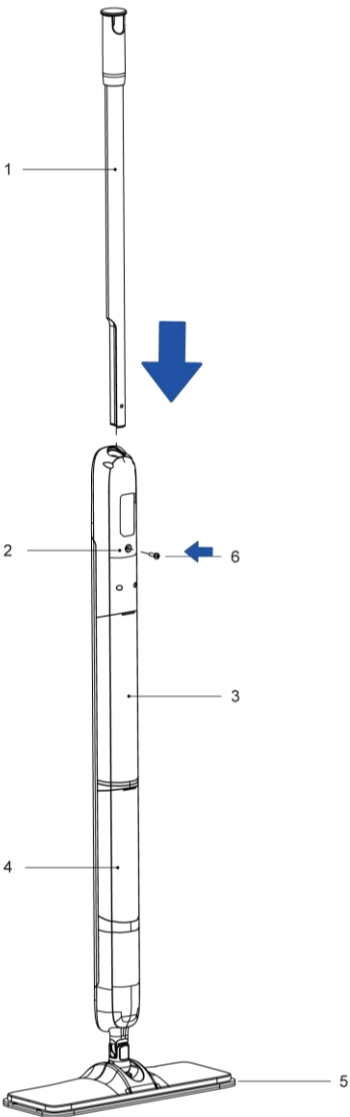
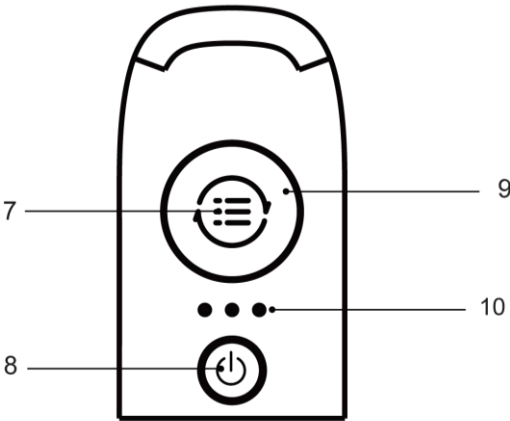
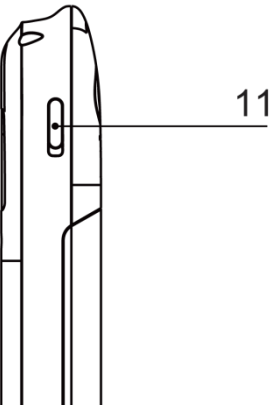

Installation:

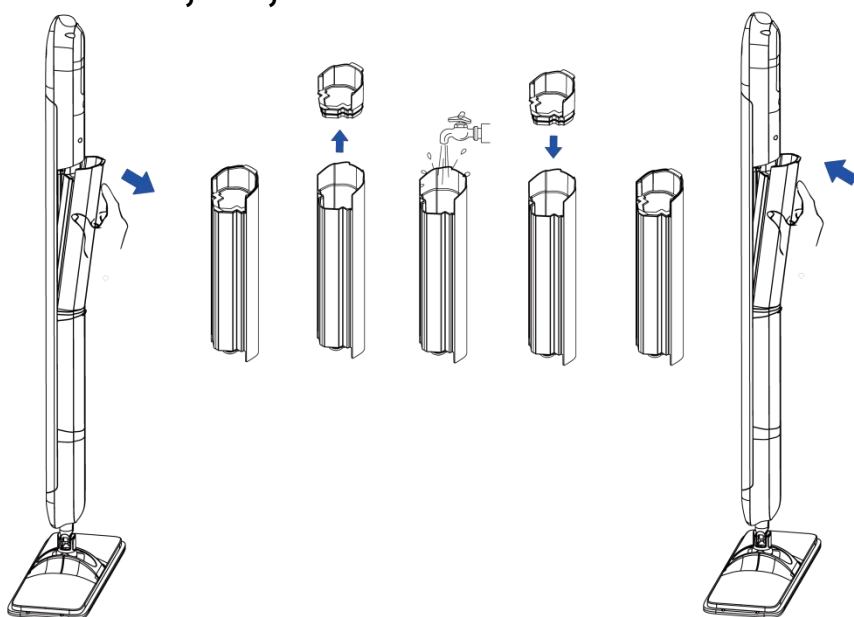
Attaching the handle

1. Insert the handle (1) into the housing of the LX-088 until it clicks fully into place.
2. Insert the fastening screw (6) into the screw hole (2) and tighten the screw.

Load

Before using the floor mop for the first time, fully charge it by connecting the USB cable to a USB charger (5V) (not included) via the charging port (11). Depending on the charger, charging may take up to 4 hours.

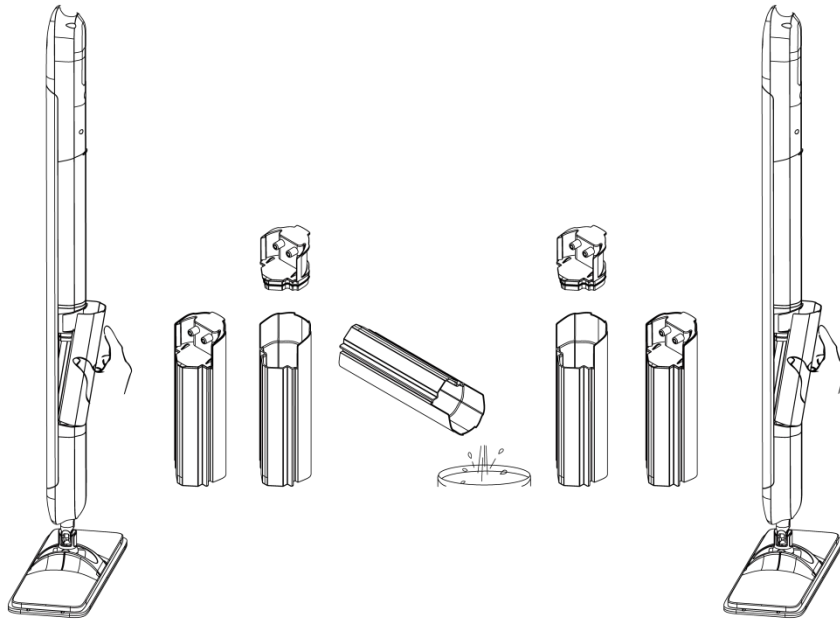
Remove, fill, and insert the fresh water tank.



Remove the water tank as shown in the images above, remove the cap,

fill the water tank (careful, observe the maximum fill line), replace the cap, and reinsert the water tank.

Remove, empty, and replace the wastewater tank.



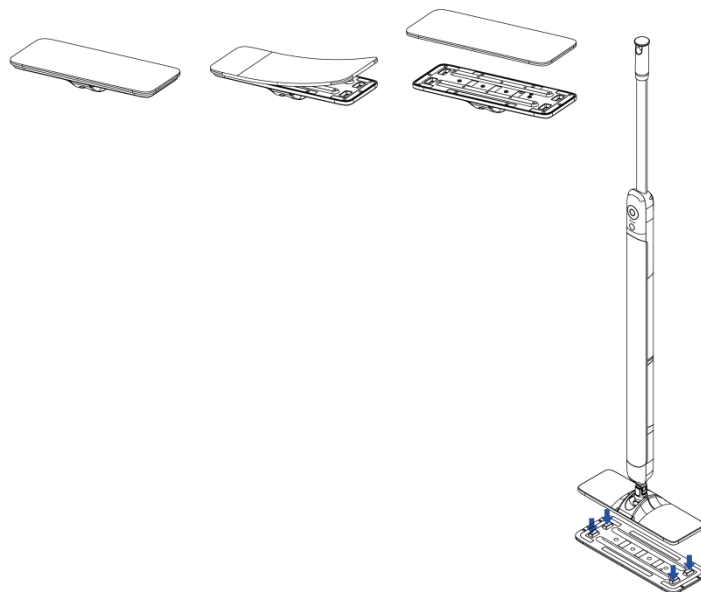
Remove the dirty water tank as shown in the images above, remove the cap, empty the tank. Replace the cap and reinsert the clean water tank.

After cleaning, empty both tanks; the dirty water tank should always be cleaned. Allow the containers to dry completely before replacing the cap.

Cleaning and replacing the cleaning pad

To remove the cleaning pad, lay the mop horizontally with the cleaning pad facing upwards. Remove the cleaning pad and wash or replace it.

Align the water inlet and outlet of the cleaning pad with the water inlet and outlet of the device, place the cleaning pad on the device, and press the floor mop down.



Commissioning:

Wiping hard floors

Note: This device is suitable for mopping hard floors, including delicate and non-absorbent floors (e.g., laminate, non-textured tiles, vinyl, PVC, wood-look parquet, poured floors, stone). Test your flooring suitability in a small, inconspicuous area first.

Vacuum the rooms to be cleaned before using the floor mop.

Remove the freshwater tank (3), remove the cap and do not fill the tank above the max. mark.

Replace the cap and install the freshwater tank.

Place the dry cleaning pad onto the recording.

Press and hold the On/Off button (8) briefly; the floor mop will start in the "wet cleaning" mode.

By pressing the mode button (7) you can switch to "intensive" cleaning or "drying" mode.

Pressing the On/Off button (8) again switches the floor wiper off.

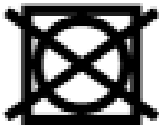
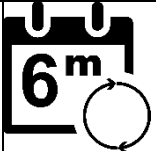
Note: If you wish to use a liquid floor cleaner, be sure to choose a non-foaming liquid floor cleaner that can be diluted with water. Using foaming floor cleaners or those that cannot be diluted with water may impair performance and cause the device to malfunction. Depending on the cleaner, 2-3 drops per fill are sufficient.

Cleaning the cleaning pad

For best results, rinse the cleaning pad under running water. Do not wring out the cleaning pad, as this may damage the backing.

The cleaning pad can be washed in the washing machine at a maximum temperature of 40°C on a gentle cycle; the washing machine should be filled to a maximum of 1/3 capacity. Do not place in the sun or on a radiator to dry.

Note: To prevent odours and limescale buildup, clean the water tank and mop head after each use. Storing the unit with residual water in the tank can damage the mop or the unit itself.

Cleaning the main unit

- Clean the device only with a dry or slightly damp, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners to clean the device.

Troubleshooting

problem	Possible cause	Solution
All 3 LEDs of the battery indicator flash red while charging.	The charging electronics or the battery have overheated	Remove the charging cable and allow the floor cleaner to cool down.
During use, all 3 LEDs of the battery indicator flash red.	Battery unit overheating	Allow the floor cleaner to cool down.
LEDs 1 and 3 are flashing red	Fault in the freshwater pump circuit	Contact support.

LEDs 1 and 3 are flashing red	Errors in the wastewater cycle	Check the water suction nozzles under the cleaning pad for blockages.
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Notes

● Do not pinch or damage the charging cable. ● Make sure that the charging cable does not come into contact with water, steam or other liquids. ● To prevent the device from malfunctioning, you must regularly check it for functionality, leaks, and damage. ● Install the product according to these instructions and operate and maintain it as directed. ● Use this product indoors only. Keep it away from rain or other liquids that could penetrate the device. ● Do not damage the product. The product may be damaged in the following cases: Accidents (including liquid or moisture), improper use or misuse of the Product, defective or improperly used Installation problems, mains supply problems including voltage spikes or lightning strikes, infestation by Insects, tampering or modification of the product by persons other than authorized service personnel Personnel, exposure to unusually corrosive substances Materials, the introduction of foreign bodies into the Unit, with accessories not approved in advance. ● Make sure the power supply is disconnected before cleaning. ● Observe all warnings and precautions in the instruction manual.

Safety instructions

● Do not disassemble the product yourself. ● Turn off the product and disconnect the power supply if you are not going to use it for an extended period of time. ● Do not use on unsealed hard floors. Always test on a small area ● before using on sensitive floors. ● Never add cleaning agents, descalers, or fragrances to the water tank. ● This device is intended for domestic use only and not for commercial use.

Safety instructions for rechargeable batteries

This product uses rechargeable batteries and can be used wherever you need it. However, ALL batteries can EXPLODE, ignite, and cause burns if disassembled, punctured, cut, crushed, short-circuited, burned, or exposed to water, fire, or high temperatures. Therefore, handle them with care.

To ensure safe use of the rechargeable batteries, follow these guidelines:

- ALWAYS make sure the battery compartment is clean and free of foreign objects before inserting new batteries.
- ALWAYS make sure that the battery contacts are correctly aligned.
