

Product overview



Charging

Please charge the BT-X66 fully with the included USB-C charging cable before first use. Plug the charging cable into the USB-C port (10) of the speaker, and the other end into a USB jack of a power-charger* (5V/1A recommend, *not included).

The LED indicator will light up. It turns off when it is fully charged. (We recommend to turn off the speaker while charging, otherwise, it will take longer time). It is fully charged after approximate 4 hours.

Warning: The device does not have power bank function. It is forbidden to charge other devices or to connect other devices with a USB cable than USB flash drive. It can occur unrepairable damage.

Button settings

- Power on/off button: Press and hold to power on /power off; short press to Play/Pause. In FM mode, short press this button to search the stations. Accept phone calls / end phone calls.
- +: Volume + / next track button: Press and hold to volume up; short press to next track. In FM mode, short press this button to next station.
- -: Volume / previous track button: Press and hold to volume down; short press to previous track. In FM mode, short press this button to previous station.
- M button: Press to change the modes: Bluetooth / FM / Micro-SD / USB / Aux-in.

Bluetooth

After power on the speaker, it is automatically in the paring state (blue flashing indicator LED). To pair the speaker with your smartphone, tablet or PC, start the Bluetooth search function on your device and connect it with "MusicMan BT-X66".

The speaker will automatically reconnect the last paired device if it is reachable. It will shut down automatically after 10 minutes if no connection occurs.

Play music from USB stick or MicroSD card

After turn on the speaker, insert USB flash drive into the USB port (8) or a MicroSD card into the MicroSD slot (9) under the cover. The speaker will play the stored music automatically if it is in on state.

Under playing mode, short press next (5) or previous (4) button to select songs. Long press to adjust the volume.

Press play/pause (3) to play or pause music.

Note: Under Bluetooth playing mode, insert USB disk will enter and play the USB / MicroSD automatically. You can press the mode button (1) to switch to Bluetooth mode again.

FM-radio

Under playing mode, short press play/pause button (3) to auto search the FM channels. They will be stored automatically in the order of occur. The order of the saved channels cannot be changed.

Short press next (5) or previous (4) button to change the stored FM channel.

Note: To improve FM radio reception, connect the USB-C charging cable (included) to the charging port.

AUX-IN

For other compatible music devices or your MP3/MP4 player, use an audio line cable to connect from the device's line-out to the Aux-In port (7) of this device, then enjoy.

Note: Skip / play / pause can only be controlled by the external device.

Care

Clean the device only with a dry or slightly damp, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners to clean the device.

Notes

•Noises are heard from the BT-X66 could be a poor Bluetooth signal. To avoid noise, stay within the Bluetooth range of ~10m. •Avoid prolonged exposure to excessive volume that may cause noise-induced hearing impairment. •Turn the volume down before start play with any sound source, then adjust it to the right volume.

- •Do not disassemble the BT-X66, it may result in short-circuit or damage.
- •Battery warning: Improper use of the battery may cause fire or chemical burns. The battery may explode in case of damage. •Do not modify, repair or remove without professional guidance. •Do not use corrosive or volatile liquid for cleaning. •Do not drop or shake the BT-X66, it may break internal circuit boards or mechanics. •Keep the BT-X66 in dry and ventilated environment. Avoid high humidity and high temperature. Also, batteries should not be exposed to excessive heat or direct sunlight. •Do not expose to water or rain. •Keep the BT-X66 away from little children.
