

Battery Installation (not included)

Open the battery compartment.

Insert 4 AAA batteries, observing the correct polarity (+/-).

Close the compartment securely.

Power On/Off

• To power the device ON or OFF, press and hold the Power button (16) until a tone sounds.

Channel Selection

- 1. Press Menu once.
- 2. Use **▲/▼** to select channel 1–8 shown in the display.
- 3. Press **TALK** or wait to confirm.

Note: All devices must be set to the same channel to communicate. For automatic channel matching, see the Scan section.

Volume Control

Press ▲ or ▼ to adjust volume.

Keypad Lock

 Press and hold the Lock button (18) for 3 seconds. To disable Lock press and hold again.

Note: Buttons 9, 10, 16, and 22 remain functional when the keypad is locked.

Flashlight

• Press the lamp button (4) to turn the flashlight ON or OFF.

Talk / Listen

- To talk, press and hold the TALK button (10).
- To listen, release the TALK button.

VOX Mode (Hands-Free)

- Press the Menu button repeatedly until "VOX" appears on the display.
- Use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to toggle VOX ON or OFF.

Note: VOX Mode allows hands-free communication by transmitting automatically when you speak.

Scan

- Press the Scan button (6) to begin scanning all 8 channels. The scan icon (2) will appear during this process.
- To stop scanning, press the Scan button again.
- When a channel is found, press the TALK button to lock it in. Note: All devices must be powered ON during scanning.

CTCSS (Continuous Tone Coded Squelch System)

CTCSS allows communication only between devices set to the same channel and subchannel, reducing interference from other users.

- 1. Press the Menu button (18) twice.
- 2. Use the ▲ / ▼ buttons to select a subchannel (OFF or 1–99).

CAUTION

- Do not invade water or other liquids.
- Keep away from flammable and explosive materials.
- This device contains small parts. Keep away from children under 3 years to avoid choking hazard.
